Education without borders

The basic human right to education has already been recognized in Article 26 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in 1948. Although it has been reaffirmed several times, there are still differences between the legal right and our reality – especially when it comes to the rights of refugees.

This time, international students from Africa, Asia and Latin America will meet refugees for the first time at a STUBE seminar!

During the first workshop, we will discuss the human right to education and whether it is realisable. Currently, the universities in Hessen are opening their doors for refugees who would like to study. However, the access to higher education remains strictly controlled, and not only for migrants. Therefore, we will take a look at the state of educational justice in higher education in Germany.

The second workshop aims at describing the importance of diversity concepts at companies in Hessen – for women and men, for disabled persons, for persons with different religious affiliations and especially for migrants. Moreover, the workshop examines what needs to change in order to achieve a successful integration of migrants – international students and refugees – in the German labour market.

In the last part, we will jointly discuss ideas and plans of taking an active part for more educational justice in our society. During this workshop, everybody will be invited to come up with initiatives to make an active contribution for more educational opportunities.
